

FIVE YEAR REVIEW OF NWT SRB ACCESS ORDER

At least 90 days prior to the expiry of each 5 year period from which an NWT SRB Access Order has been made, the NWT SRB will notify, in writing (paper or electronic), the Parties (or their successors if they have notified the NWT SRB of succession) that the NWT SRB intends to review the Order (SRBA s. 86)

Parties waive the requirement for a 5 Year Review

Parties maintain the requirement for a 5 Year Review (SRBA s. 86 (1))

Party who fails, within 30 days before the expiry of each 5 year period to make a written (paper or electronic) representation to the NWT SRB with respect to a 5 Year Review is deemed to have waived the requirement for a 5 Year Review (SRBA s. 86 (3))

Within 30 days before the expiry of each 5 year period a Party makes a written (paper or electronic) representation to the NWT SRB waiving the right to a 5 Year Review. (SRBA s. 86 (2))

“Upon completion of its review of an access order, the Board shall make any amendments to the Order that it considers appropriate if it determines that there has been a material change in the facts or circumstances relating to the order that would justify amending it.. (SRBA s. 86 (4))
